Old cars and trucks, need to be licensed to be able to be kept in the drive way. They cannot have flat tires on them. If you see such vehicles that do not meet these requirements please call Bexar County Sheriff's office and they will be cited for them.

I am looking forward to everyone getting their property in order and having a successful DYJ. Make sure your current dues are paid and you get your Dumping Pass. They can be paid at the check in table.

## Dump Your Junk:

For those of you who were not in attendance at the April Member Meeting, Dump Your Junk will be going forward on Saturday, May 9 from 9am to 6pm and Sunday, May 10, from 1pm to 5pm. It will be in a new location this year due to the sale of the location where it has been held in past years. There will also be a slightly different procedure. Check in will be set up at the side driveway of 9590 Dunstable (this is the home across from the old pond area lot). Where you will be checked for current membership status for the October 1, 2014 -2015 year, pick up your two day DUMPING PASS and be given instructions and directions for dumping. You may pay your dues at the check in site as they will not be accepting them at the dumping lot. You only need to check in once to receive your dumping pass.

As in the past Garbage bags will NOT be accepted. Other banned items include: tires, paint, toxic materials, anything with Freon, refrigerators, etc. Bring all your old metal for recycling.

Please remember that all the people working these events are volunteers, taking time out of their days so that you have the opportunity to use this service. Special thanks to Barry Hunt our MRNA President and his Presidential Assistant, Billie, who worked so diligently finding a way to continue Dump Your Junk.

## Through Sidewalk:

There has been concern that the new owner of the property would be closing off the through sidewalk that connects Millers Ridge and Chemsford. At the March MRNA meeting County Commissioner Tommy Calvert and Andrew Winter with Code Compliance said that they would reach out to the owner and see if they would be agreeable to moving the fence line and give the sidewalk to County who owns the other half of the side walk on the Chemsford side. The owner has agreed to this. The sidewalk will remain accessible to the public. MRNA will continue to pay for the lights in that area and maintain the grounds. One of the many things your MRNA dues go towards.

You may also call this number for a Patrol By. Also call 210-335-4750 for the Constables Pct. 4 for a PATROL BY, so you get both services from two different agencies.
- Call **Bexar County Animal Control** at **210-207-6650** regarding loose Dogs or Cats. They will provide a cage to catch stray cats. **Remember Bexar County has a Leash Law.** They do have to be registered and licensed.
