This year March, June, August and November are 5 Monday months. You will be reported and fined if trash is put out early or left out more than 3 days. Call 311 if you're not certain of the date and/or type of trash.

It is important that you follow the schedules for the different kinds of trash pickups on designated times. Where do you get the schedule? It is located in the Gulf Meadows Monthly Newsletter or you may check with the city of Houston for information by phoning 3-1-1. So, be on the lookout for your newsletter near the end of each month. REMEMBER: HEAVY TRASH CAN ONLY BE PUT OUT AS EARLY AS THE FRIDAY BEFORE THE 4TH MONDAY OF THE MONTH.

Gulf Meadows is not an HOA (Home Owners Association). We have a very active Civic Club that works very hard to keep our residences and area maintained legally, per Houston City Ordinances, per our Deed Restrictions and with close support with our Houston Police Department Storefront (located in our immediate area) and separate Police Patrol.

Our Civic Club dues are non-mandatory at \$40 a year, BUT any new resident should be encouraged to pay and become a member.

The City of Houston is without zoning and HOAs and Civic Clubs are the neighborhoods' best protection against deterioration which can happen very quickly without any supervision.

#### Heavy Tree and Junk Trash Schedules

Heavy tree trash pickup: tree trash, mixed with junk will not be picked up.

**Junk trash pickup:** includes furniture, appliances, other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etcetera.). Appliances containing refrigerant must be tagged to certify that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant.

Tree or junk put out too early (before the weekend of the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of the month), will be reported to 311 and you will be fined by the city of Houston.

Place for pickup close to the curb, NOT IN THE STREET, for easy access by the collection vehicle. Place by the Friday before, and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day (4th Monday of each month).
