You will be reported and fined if trash is put out early or left out more than 3 days. Call 311 if you're not certain of the date and/or type of trash.

Heavy Tree and Junk Trash Schedules

Heavy tree trash pickup: tree trash, mixed with junk will not be picked up.

Junk trash pickup: includes furniture, appliances, other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etcetera.). Appliances containing refrigerant must be tagged to certify that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant. **Tree or junk** put out too early **(before the weekend of the 4th Monday of the month)**, will be reported to 311 and you will be fined by the city of Houston.

Place for pickup close to the curb NOT IN THE STREET, for easy access by the collection vehicle. Place by the Friday before, and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day (4h Monday of each month).
