Every 4th Monday is pick-up in our area. This month the date is November 23rd for TREE WASTE. This year November is a 5 Monday month. Do not put trash out on the 5th Monday, Nov. 30th. You will be reported and fined if trash is put out early or left out more than 3 days. Call 311 if you're not certain of the date and/or type of trash, or to report early trash placement.

Deed Restrictions

Parking On The Grass - Some residents of Gulf Meadows have started parking on the grass again. As a reminder, the Parking Ordinance is permanent! No one is to park on the grass in Gulf Meadows! The ordinance does not change nor can it be ignored as the resident pleases. It is important that all residents follow the ordinance, "No Parking on the Grass"!

Junk Vehicles - Also, many junk vehicles with expired tags are parked on the streets. Do not park on the street with expired tags! You will be ticketed if caught.

Junk Vehicles on the Driveways - Many of us park our broken down vehicles on our driveways with the plan to repair them. Often that never happens, because we buy another and another vehicle, and nothing ever gets repaired. Maybe there is a financial burden or you have a hard time getting rid of the old vehicle. No matter what the case may be, hoarding causes a neighborhood to breakdown, and eventually, the area turns into a ghetto. Please work with us, and remove all broken down vehicles from our neighborhood, and keep Gulf Meadows a place that we are proud to call "Home".

Heavy Tree and Junk Trash Schedules

Heavy tree trash pickup: tree trash, mixed with junk will not be picked up.

Junk trash pickup: includes furniture, appliances, other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etcetera.). Appliances containing refrigerant must be tagged to certify that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant.


Tree or junk put out too early (before the weekend of the 4th Monday of the month), will be reported to 311

Place for pickup close to the curb NOT IN THE STREET, for easy access by the collection vehicle. Place by the Friday before, and no later than 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day (4h Monday of each month).
