#### Mosquito Invasion

Mosquito-borne illnesses that affect both humans and pets, include:

- Zika Virus
- Dog Heartworm
- West Nile Virus
- Encephalitis
- Malaria
- Yellow Fever
- Filariasis
- Dengue Fever
- Elephantiasis
- Chikungungunya Virus

Houston mosquitoes are considered to be some of the worst in the United States. Of the 2,500+ mosquito species throughout the world, 80 of the most aggressive live in Texas. Mosquitos are arriving by worldwide transportation into the USA via vehicles, planes, ships and immigration. The new Zika virus in pregnant women causes babies to have brain damage and it spreads sexually. The City of Houston sprays ditches, esplanades, vacant land, etc, BUT if we are to protect our housing area, additional spraying is a must. To do your part, clean up trash, junk, and supplies stored or kept outside, and keep your weeds and grass short. If you notice any tall grass or trash on property near your home call 3-1-1 for help from the city to take care of the problem. THIS IS WAR AGAINST THE MOSQUITOS.

Please pay your dues. \$40 a year is a cheap investment. If you see an area that needs attention, please, please, please contact us or the city.

### President's Message

We have not had, to this point in time, what we would normally consider winter weather. It will not be long before spring arrives and we all are doing our spring thing in our gardens and yards. We have, however, experienced a wetter winter than usual. All of our creeks, bayous and ditches are full of standing water - a breeding environment for mosquitos. Now we must add another disease virus to the lengthening list of illnesses and diseases caused by mosquito bites.

The city of Houston and Harris County spray for mosquitos, BUT only in areas where there is confirmation of the disease carrying insects. Your Civic Club, on the other hand, sprays regularly during the spring and summer when the mosquitos are most active and prevalent. This is a benefit provided only in our Gulf Meadows subdivision. We sometimes have to spray outside of our contract and spray as needed. We have 300 families (1/3) who pay dues to help maintain our program which protects all of our residents from these mosquito borne diseases.

You are urged to do your part in bearing the cost by paying your dues.

#### Parking in the Yard City Ordinance

#### **Deed Restrictions**

Kudos to all Gulf Meadows residents who work so very hard keeping their property junk free in this community! The more rubbish we get rid of, the more rodents go away. I challenge all neighbors to join in and continue the fight on RODENTS!! Important Things to Remember:

- Only put HEAVY TRASH out a couple of days before the pickup date.
- Please do not put HEAVY TRASH out on any day that you clean up. Keep it out of sight until it is time for pickup.
- HEAVY TRASH has a specific time to be put out. PLEASE get the scheduled time for heavy trash pickup from your neighborhood NEWSLETTER that we put on your porch.
- 4. The Deed Restriction Committee is asking all residents to report all broken down vehicles and/or vehicles with expired tags parked on the street to the police nonemergency number or call our neighborhood police sub-station to report. 713-991-3504.



### **Heavy Tree and Junk Trash Schedules**

Heavy tree trash pickup: tree trash, mixed with junk will not be picked up.

Junk trash pickup: includes furniture, appliances, other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etcetera.).

Appliances containing refrigerant must be tagged to certify that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant.

Tree or junk put out too early (before the weekend of the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of the month), will be reported to 311 and you will be fined by the city of Houston.

Trash placement for pickup close to the curb NOT IN THE STREET, for easy access by the collection vehicle. Trash may be placed the Friday before, and by 7:00 a.m. on the scheduled collection day (4h Monday of each month). Any questions call 311.
