





# El Dorado COMMUNITY GARDEN

The El Dorado community has teamed up with UTSA Architecture students and Green Spaces Alliance to bring to you your very own community garden at 12606 Prima Vista St. Currently, the Clubhouse has served as an event center for local families and will be extending a neighborly hand with an organic alternative to produce, an honest trade of labor, and a traditional unity of community. The intention of the garden is to cultivate multigenerational activity and multicultural appreciation through horticulture education.

Students and volunteers alike broke ground in February, in efforts to repurpose and revitalize the old tennis courts by removing the asphalt and clearing out obstructions. The next phase of development is the construction of essential gardening amenities.

Your local garden will include raised beds, fruit trees, compost bins, a pergola that will provide shade and community identity, and a harvest station with a built in water catchment system, tool storage, and sink with countertop space to aid in washing and trimming of personal produce or for public demonstration.

In partnership with Green Spaces Alliance, both pergola, and harvest station structures are designed and built by UTSA Professor, Darryl Ohlenbusch's, senior design studio. The designs are site specific, and tailored to the movement of labor, with inviting orientations creating a new scenic experience.



The harvest station will be the first structure to be completed this summer by the efforts of fundraising and donations. All progression is achieved through the advance of a unified vision, and the generosity of the kind and able.


