### **Illegal Dumping**

Chapter 10, Section 482(b) of the City of Houston Code of Ordinances says, "No garbage, rubbish, waste, or manure shall be placed, left, dumped, or permitted to accumulate or remain in any building or premises in the city so that same shall or may afford food or a harboring or breeding place for rats."

In order to keep our community a decent place to live, each of us should take responsibility for reporting illegal dump sites, overflowing dumpsters, etc. Call 311 or use the Harris County Precinct 1 "No Dumping" Program by calling Cedric Johnson at 281-445-1617 or e-mailing him at Cedric.Johnson@cp1. hctx.net to report trash dumped in ditches or lots.

Keep District K Beautiful Day is April 9, 2016. Plan to be proactive and use the week of April 9 to report dump sites, weeded lots, discarded tires, "bandit" signs, etc.
