





Kelly and I are looking forward to this challenge and we want to meet some of the requests we've heard like:

We'll try this in June, if it's used we'll keep the new times, if not, we'll change it back, but whatever we do, we will post it at the sign-in table, and on Facebook. Are you on Facebook? After your first visit, you'll check in, the gatekeeper finds your ID on the tablet, and you enjoy your swim! This is a new and less expensive way to identify you. We know NEW might mean a few glitches here or there, please be patient with us, we are learning too!

Speaking of expenses, it's time we ALL pitch in and help keep our neighborhood; grounds, lake, pool, clubhouse, and paseo not just beautiful, but safe. Both the pool and clubhouse are in desperate need of facelifts, El Dorado has over 700 homes and less than 1/3 of the neighborhood pays the minimum maintenance fee, even less pay full membership! This isn't enough to pay the bills AND repair, paint, replace, resurface the pool, and rehab the outside bathrooms! There <u>was</u> talk about filling in our pool but that does not have to happen if we all get involved to save it. 
