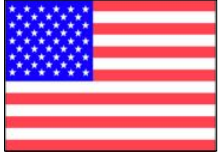

Hello Everyone, A quick reminder, remember to renew your annual JNA dues this August. The cost is \$10.00 per individual, \$15.00 per family, and \$25 for Business members. Please enclose the completed last page of this newsletter in your response envelope. All new residents to the neighborhood will be eligible to participate in our new campaign which allows you a free membership to the JNA for one year. Thereafter you will be asked to donate the aforementioned amounts depending on your circumstances.

Transportation and Capital Improvements will give a presentation at our next meeting August 8th. TCI oversees street and drainage maintenance, capital projects for the City of San Antonio, and both the 2007 and 2012 bonds. They will provide us with information concerning all the current and projected projects in our neighborhood.

The Tier One Neighborhood Coalition was founded in June 2016, and is comprised of 12 neighborhood associations. It was formed in response to an appeal filed to the City which addressed a section of the Neighborhood Conservation District (NCD) which included commercial property. The developer working on the development of a Stripes Convenience store and gas station on the corner of Fredericksburg Rd. and Woodlawn contacted the Beacon Hill Area Neighborhood Association (BHANA) the same day they filed the appeal, threatening to sue if BHANA proceeded with their appeal. This is a cliff hanger. I will report more information about this at our next meeting. I look forward to seeing everyone at our next meeting on August 8, at 7:00 PM at Jackson Hall, located at the Jefferson United Methodist Church across the street from Thomas Jefferson H.S.

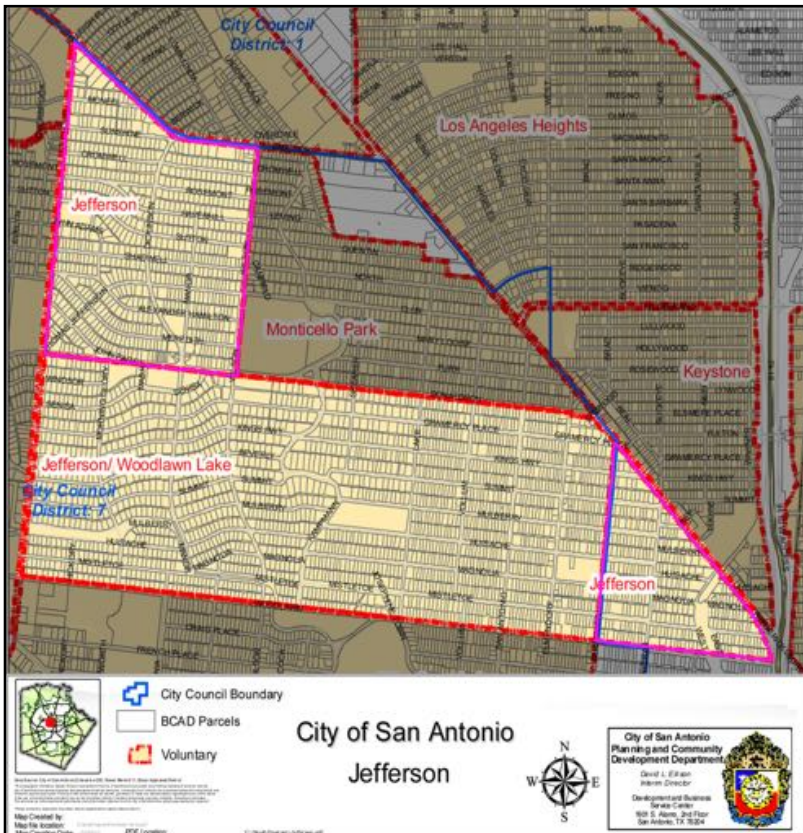

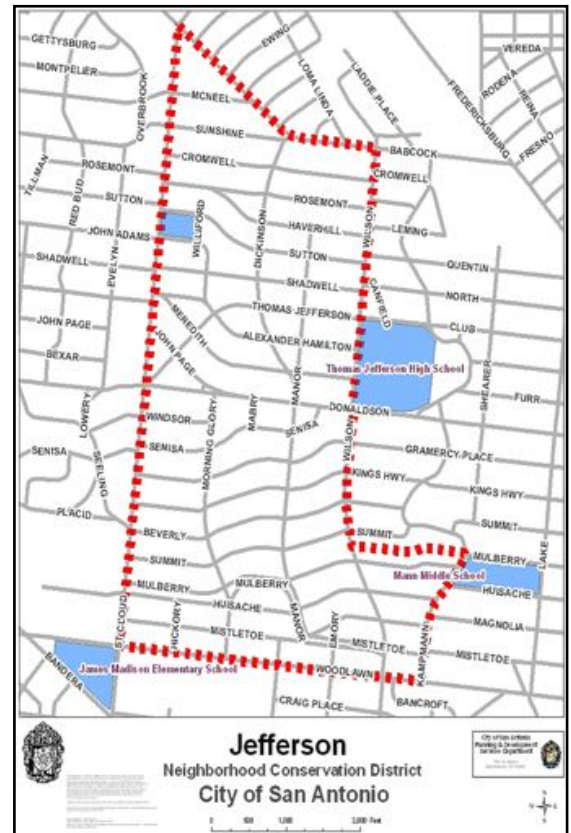
