# Unlawful **Restraint Of Dog Ordinance Passed**

The Public Safety and Veterans Subcommittee unanimously recommended approval the Unlawful Restraint of Dog Ordinance; also known as the "Tethering Ordinance." The ordinance will be sent to the full City Council for approval. The term "tethering" refers to the practice of fastening a dog to a stationary object and leaving the dog unattended. The term "chaining" refers to tethering a dog with a heavy metal chain. Tethering often involves the partial restraint of a dog through use of a rope, light chain, or pulley. Tethering does not include restraint by leash while walking a dog or temporary tethering when the owner is present. Tethering a dog can severely damage the dog's physical and psychological well-being. Many jurisdictions have enacted ordinances to combat the negative impact of tethering dogs. Current Arizona and City of Phoenix animal cruelty laws do not expressly prohibit dog tethering. The proposed ordinance amends Phoenix City Code Section 8, relating to animals, and prohibits the act of unlawful restraint of dogs. The proposed ordinance prohibits the restraint of a dog as follows:

- 1) No restraint may unreasonably limit the dog's movement. "Unreasonably limit the dog's movement is defined as a restraint that:
- a) Uses a pinch-type, prong-type, or choke-type collar that is not properly fitted to the dog:
- b) Is in length shorter than 10 feet;
- c) Places the dog in unsafe or unsanitary conditions;
- d) Causes injury to the dog; or
- e) Does not permit the dog access to food, water, shade, dry ground or shelter.

Investigators continue to ask that residents remain vigilant and report suspicious activity, including unfamiliar people or vehicles, in their neighborhoods. # New Dog Ordinance Continued from page.....1

- 2) No dog may be restrained during extreme weather conditions. "Extreme weather conditions" are defined as:
- a) Outdoor temperatures below 32 degrees Fahrenheit or above 100 degrees Fahrenheit;
- b) Anytime a heat advisory has been issued by a local, state, or national authority for the area; or
- c) A monsoon, hurricane, tropical-storm, dust-storm, or tornado warning has been issued for A first offense is cited as a civil violation. A subsequent offense is cited as a Class 1 Misdemeanor.
