We have a new alarm monitoring system in the East Pool and West Office buildings, provided by Precision Security of Oklahoma.

They suggested giving our residents the following security tips for the newsletter:

As we begin to enter into the holiday season, please be aware that this time of the year home invasions and property crimes increase. 93% of all home invasions occur at the front door, back door or a lowlying window in a non-lit area.

If possible, please make sure that all sides of your home are well-lit. If you are going to be traveling, make sure a trusted neighbor and/or a family member retrieve your mail and if you still get the newspaper, that as well

We'd like to add that one of the best defenses is to be a good neighbor. Watch for and report any suspicious activity to the police.

For proper credit, please be sure to specify your name and address in the message box. If you are paying for a Pool membership, you must still send us a completed pool application form.

Or

If you don't have a PayPal account, and wish to use a credit card, you must pay for an <u>entire year's dues</u> (<u>or the full pool membership fee</u>) at one time.

The following payment information is required:

Credit card number, Expiration Date, and CVV or CV2 (3 or 4 digit number on back of card)

Please send payment information and a copy of your statement to the address on your statement.

Please Pay Your Dues on Time!

Homeowners that fail to pay their dues will be taken to small claims court

Effective January 1, 2016 there is a \$1.00 per month service charge for delinquent accounts.

Our dues have not increased in years, leaving us (in effect) with less and less to work with each year. Every dollar collected is used to maintain and improve our neighborhood.
