## **Weekly Trash Collection**

Garbage collection.......Friday Mornings
Yard Trimmings.....Friday Mornings
(clear logo bag or tied limb bundles)
Green bin Recycling - November 4<sup>th</sup> & 18<sup>th</sup>

## **Yard Trimmings**

Grass clippings and leaves must not be placed in a garbage can. They must be in a city approved compostable bag not weighing more than 50 pounds and placed at the curb 3 feet away from a black garbage can. Small branches and vines may be tied in bundles in 4 - 5 feet lengths and 18 inches in diameter weighing less than 50 pounds. Yard trimmings mixed with any other type of waste will not be collected. Motor oil will be picked up when set to the side of a green bin. Contractor work must be removed by the contractor.

Heavy tree trash pickup: tree trash, mixed with junk will not be picked up.

**Junk trash includes:** furniture, appliances, other bulky material (lumber, fence material, etc.). Appliances containing refrigerant must be tagged to certify that a qualified technician has removed the refrigerant.

Junk and small tree trash may be put out the Friday before the weekend of the 4<sup>th</sup> Monday of the month,

BUT separate the junk from the small tree trash. Trash put out before then or left out should be reported to 311 and is subject to fine by the city of Houston.
