Dump Your Junk update:

Dump your junk is scheduled to take place on Saturday May 14 and Sunday May 22, 2015, 9am to 5pm and 1pm to 5pm, respectively. The hours may vary slightly depending on the volunteers available. It will be in the same area as it was in the fall by millers Point Elementary. This give you the opportunity to get your yards cleaned up and dispose of some of your spring cleaning or projects you may be doing. You can get rid of junk, tree trimmings, etc. Remember no garbage, that is for your garbage service, no paint cans, and nothing with Freon. This is your last opportunity to get rid of your offensive junk. There will also be a dumpster for metal recycling. MRNA Rules: No dumpster diving in the metal container; No animals or children under 18 at dump site; No exceptions. You may pay your \$30 dues at this time.
