





All volunteers get to share what the Garden produces, pick some tomatoes from the beds identified as Community Beds and enjoy! We will soon have pumpkins, onions, peppers, broccoli, romaine lettuce and squash to share also.

We want to thank Lisa Clipperton, her family and Affordable Appliance Haul Off & Repair Company for donating the beautiful outdoor picnic table with a roof top to provide shade and shelter for our Community Garden. They not only donated and delivered this piece of art, but the Clipperton's customized it to fit our Garden's needs! We appreciate and thank them!

Coming soon to the Garden is a Pergola to host gatherings and provide shelter to our gardeners and visitors. The materials and construction will be donated by Home Depot at Windcrest. The preparation and planting of a few areas designated to attract Pollinators. 
