50 gallon CFT (Continuous Flow Through)-Wheelie Worm Bin Workshop

April 8th at 9:00 a.m.

- Cost is \$55 for the presentation, starter food and a pound of worms.
- Or, cost of presentation and worm bin construction is \$40.
- This is a make and take workshop on how to compost with worms without having to turn it...vermicomposting.
- In class, you will build your own 50 gallon CFT Bin, starter food stock, and \$30 value of starter red worms. Instructions on bin care from a Certified State of Texas Alliance Recycle-Master Composter.
- No turning compost. Let earthworms to do the job.
- Bin looks similar to S.A. brown trash bins. Similar sized bins cost \$300.00.


