Did You Know?

- Everyone's water bill is high. Here are some facts about water usage:
- Dishwashers on average use 6 gallons of water per cycle, while Energy Star dishwashers use 4 gallons.
- Toilets built before 1982 use 5 to 7 gallons every flush. Newer toilets use 1.6 gallons every flush.
- Standard washing machines use about 23 gallons of water per load. Older washing machines use 40-50 gallons per load.
- The average family of 4 uses 400 gallons of water a day.

The township trustees are currently working with Franklin County to reduce the water bills. Also, please attend the bi-weekly Township meetings that are on Wednesdays.


