

Addresses of individual yard sales are listed on maps that are handed out to shoppers at each home participating in the event, directing shoppers to other sales in the square. The event is advertised in the Arizona Republic, on their online listings and on Craig's list. The more homes participating, the more impressive the ad will be. Please sign up by February 26th. The cost to place your own personal ad would be much more than with the group price. **The fee for paid members of the association is \$10** and for non-members is \$20.

We will also have signs at the main entrances into our square and a couple at 31st & Orangewood advertising the BIG sale in our square mile.

You set your own hours of operation. This is a great chance to meet your neighbors, serve coffee & donuts too, and add to your profits. I hope that this summer everyone had a chance to clean out the garage, the attic, closets, and spare rooms.

We need to have a minimum of 20 homes participating for the neighborhood yard sale to continue this year. Unfortunately, if we don't reach this number, we will have to cancel this year's sale.

In the Garden



January

The only winter month in Phoenix.

- Spray dormant shrubs.
- Last chance to plant bare roots trees and shrubs.
- Prune roses and deciduous fruit trees.
- Monitor freeze warnings
- Plant summer bulbs.

February

- Weed prevention with pre-emergence herbicide.
- Complete rose and deciduous tree pruning.
- Start spring planting.

After the 15:

- Start fertilizing
- Start planting frost tender plants and shrub.

In the vegetable garden

- Plant bare roots asparagus and strawberries.
- Plant cabbage, carrots, lettuce, potatoes, radishes

In the vegetable garden

- Plant beets, bush beans, cantaloupe, carrots, corn, eggplant, lettuce, peppers, potatoes, radishes, summer squash, tomatoes, watermelon.

From the NorthGlen Kitchen

Winter Pomegranate Slaw

Ready in: 15 min Serves: 6 to 8

Ingredients:

1-1/2 lbs Brussels sprouts, shredded (should amout to about 6 cups)

1 fennel bulb and stalks, shredded

1-1/2 cups sliced almonds

1 cup pomegranate seeds/arils

1 cup roasted, salted sunflower seeds

1/3 cup olive oil

1/3 cup golden balsamic vinegar

2 garlic cloves

1 teaspoon minced fresh thyme

1/2 teaspoon salt

1/2 teaspoon pepper

Directions:

- 1. Cut the ends off the Brussels sprouts, then put them in a food processor (with the blade insert). Pulse until sliced into a slaw. Pour into a large bowl.
- 2. Cut fennel into small chunks, place in food processor, and pulse until sliced into a slaw. Pour into bowl with sliced Brussels sprouts.
- 3. Mince garlic.
- 4. Remove thyme leaves from stems and mince.
- 5. In a small bowl, stir together garlic, thyme, balsamic vinegar, olive oil, salt, and pepper.
- 6. Pour dressing over slaw and toss until coated.
- 7. Pour in sunflower seeds, sliced almonds, and pomegranate seeds. Stir until mixed.


