Spring Clean Up Project

Volunteers are needed for a clean-up project in the subdivision. Meet at 8:00 AM Saturday, April 28 at the corner of Antler and Fox Drive. Wear boots, bring gloves and a snow-type shovel if you have one. We will be filling a 20 yard roll-off dumpster. The dumpster will be available after April 28 through May 2 until it is filled for Hunter's Ridge homeowners to drop off household items they haven't had time to take to the landfill (this is not for trash from a private business, but rather for small things you can't put in your regular trash pickup). The dumpster cannot be overfilled. Below is a list of items that **CANNOT** be put into the dumpster.

*PAINT*PRESSURIZED TANKS*LIQUIDS/OILS/WET CONCRETE*TIRES*DRY CEMENT*BRICKS*REFRIGERATORS/AIR CONDITIONERS*YARD WASTE*HAZARDOUS OR ILLEGAL MATERIALS*HOT ASHES*WOOD*HEAVY OR HARD METAL*HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES (TVS,COMPUTERS...)

We are also collecting up to 15 tires for a donation of \$3 each for the retailer who is taking them for us. We will collect these separately in a truck on April 28 only. Please have cash on hand at pickup. Regualr size tires only. This is to eliminate a breeding ground for mosquitos and are also unsightly in the neighborhood.
