PRESIDENT'S LETTER

Dear Neighbors,

I want to thank each of our new and renewing members for taking care of their dues before the end of the month of May. Your dues keep us going. It is never too late to turn in your membership form and become a member, and the pool is open right now, just as it is really starting to heat up out there. Sandra Carroll and Jenn McRae and Shannon Grabill have done an outstanding job getting the pool ready for the summer.

We recently held a very successful Mayfest Fundraiser at the pool and clubhouse. John Easterling and Eric Tietze and I all had a wonderful time giving away our homemade brews and meeting some of our neighbors for the first time. We couldn't have done it without Nora Chavez and Margaret Timm and all of the board members who came out to support our effort to raise funds to resurface the bottom of the pool and remodel the clubhouse.

I am sometimes asked about our budget and whether your dues cover all of our expenses. The short answer is that they do not, at least not yet. We spend around \$40,000 each year on pool chemicals and services, life guards, repairs, lawn services, mowing equipment for the lake, the Sunburst, utilities (water and power) and various insurance policies. With membership running at less than 250 homes (out of 750 total) on average, membership dues cover about two-thirds of our annual expenses. The other third is covered by clubhouse rentals, pool party rentals and Sunburst advertising. We get by, but there isn't much left over each year for big repairs and remodels.

Our facilities are almost 50 years old. Dedicated volunteers such as Conrad Boeck, Kurt Schaeffer, Evelyn Canion, are working hard to keep the gremlins from doing too much damage. John Cook and James Friesenhahn and other quiet heroes are keeping the lake and Paseo looking their best. Still, there are some long-term wear-and-tear issues that need to be addressed sooner rather than later. El Dorado has been in tough spots before (the pool was once considered for permanent closure several years ago) but volunteers always step in and help us manage. The current board of EDHA and all of those who answer the call to serve their neighbors are working hard, and I know we can continue to meet our challenges.

But I would like to do more than just meet our basic needs. I frequently get calls from real estate agents about the pool. We charge less for a pool membership than other nearby neighborhoods (if they still have a pool), and that attracts homebuyers. An updated clubhouse would help bring in more revenue and provide members with an attractive space to hold gatherings and parties. If we could get our paying membership up to 50%, we could start saving more towards the repairs and upgrades that we need. Please join me and EDHA today.

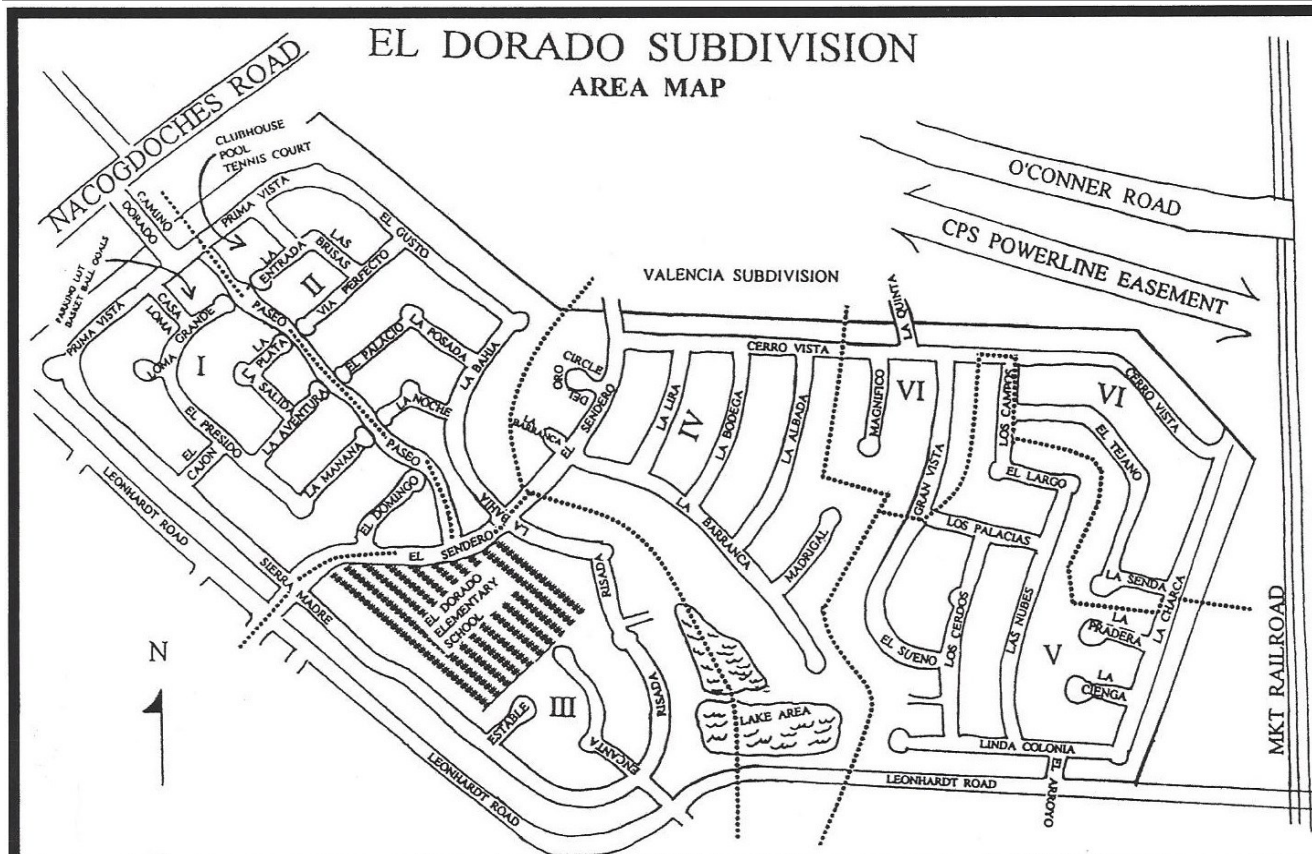

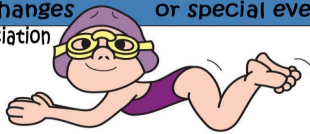

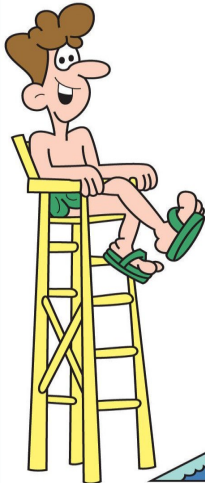
