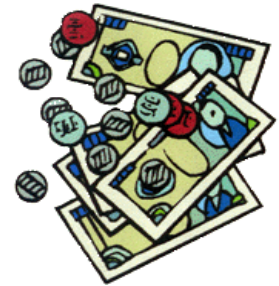
Volunteer Opportunities

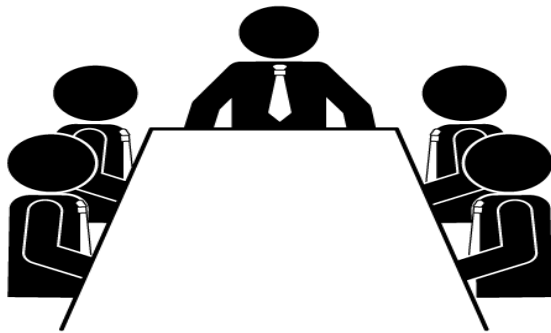
