

Trash Collection Day Change for the Holidays

- Thanksgiving Day—Thursday, Nov. 22, 2018 collection moves to Friday, Nov. 23, and Friday's collection moves to Saturday, Nov. 24.
- Christmas Day—Tuesday, Dec. 25, 2018 collection day moves one day later (e.g.: Tuesday collection moves to Wednesday, Wednesday to Thursday... Friday to Saturday)
- New Year's Day—Tuesday, Jan. 1, 2019 collection day moves one day later (e.g.: Tuesday's collection moves to Wednesday, Wednesday to Thursday... Friday to Saturday)



FREE Driver's Ed Program! at Phoenix Public Library



Do you feel there might be a Grand Canyon between you and getting a motor vehicle license in Arizona? Learn how to travel the saguaros in safety with our guides and MVD practice tests designed to get you ready for the licensing exams for cars, motorcycles, and commercial driving. For your permit or license to drive a car, you need to get 80% right to pass (that's 24 out of the 30 questions). If you don't pass, you will have to wait a humiliating length of time before retaking, so study up here. There's even a marathon test with questions that are very similar (if not identical) to the test you'll be taking.

Italian Style Winter Soup

Ingredients

- 2 tablespoons Olive oil
- 3 Cloves garlic, minced
- 2 tablespoons chopped green onion (white part only)
- 4 (3.5 oz.) links Italian sausage sliced
- 8 cups chicken stock
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 tablespoon dried basil
- 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
- 2 cans (4 ounces) pieces & stems mushrooms
- 2 cups uncooked white or brown rice 1/2 cup heavy cream **OR** for a lighter version 1/2 cup 1% milk combined with 1 tbsp. corn starch (whisk together in a separate bowl before adding to your soup mixture)

Directions

- 1. Heat oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add garlic and onion and sauté for 3 minutes, or until tender. Add the sausage, browning well on all sides, about 5 minutes.
- 2. Add the chicken stock, oregano, basil, parsley and mushrooms. Bring to a boil, reduce heat to low and simmer for 1 hour.
- 3. Add the rice and simmer for 30 more minutes. Finally, add the cream, stirring well. Remove from heat and let soup rest for 5 minutes before serving.
