Do you feel there might be a Grand Canyon between you and getting a motor vehicle license in Arizona? For your permit or license to drive a car, you need to get 80% right to pass (that's 24 out of the 30 questions). If you don't pass, you will have to wait a humiliating length of time before retaking, so study up here. Italian Style Winter Soup

Ingredients

2 tablespoons Olive oil
 3 Cloves garlic, minced
 2 tablespoons chopped green onion (white part only)
 4 (3.5 oz.) links Italian sausage sliced
 8 cups chicken stock
 1 teaspoon dried oregano
 1 tablespoon dried basil
 1/4 cup chopped fresh parsley
 2 cans (4 ounces) pieces & stems mushrooms
 2 cups uncooked white or brown rice
 1/2 cup heavy cream **OR** for a lighter version
 1/2 cup 1% milk combined with 1 tbsp. corn starch (whisk together in a separate bowl before adding to your soup mixture)

Directions

1. Heat oil in a large pot over medium heat. Add garlic and onion and sauté for 3 minutes, or until tender. Add the sausage, browning well on all sides, about 5 minutes.
2. Add the chicken stock, oregano, basil, parsley and mushrooms. Bring to a boil, reduce heat to low and simmer for 1 hour.
3. Add the rice and simmer for 30 more minutes. Finally, add the cream, stirring well. Remove from heat and let soup rest for 5 minutes before serving.
