NEW PROJECTS IN THE WORKS

Did you notice the new mulch at Doxsey Circle and Augustine Entryway. We also had the sprinkler system repaired, so you will soon see the grass turning green again. In the next couple of weeks the flag and pole will be changed and all electric will be repaired to meet current code and both common areas will be illuminated at night with high efficiency solar lighting.
