## ElectionINFORMATION

The Bexar County Elections Department is responsible for voter registration activities and election operations throughout Bexar County.

This includes 712 voting precincts, 53 political subdivisions, 20 Independent School Districts, 29 Cities, 3 Military Installations (including Lackland AFB, Fort Sam Houston, and Randolph Air Force Base), and over **1,086,432 registered voters**.

#### CHECK YOUR VOTER INFORMATION

To check to see if your information matches, visit the <u>Texas Secretary of State's Voter Registration page</u>. Put in your birthdate and house number and it will give you the name you currently have on your official voter registration card. You can also call the Elections Department at 210-335-VOTE (8683).

Make sure your voter information is up to date. If you've moved, changed apartments or your name, your voter information must be updated.

Early voting for the March 3 "Super Tuesday" election starts Tuesday, February 18 and runs through Friday, February 28, 2020.





Every decade the United States Census Bureau conducts a count of all the nations' residents. The next Census Day is April 1st, 2020. Getting counted is an important way to contribute to your community, today and for the next 10 years. Census data impacts essential public services provided by states and local governments like healthcare, public safety, education and transportation. The Census determines our representation in Congress and is used in redistricting at the state and local level. Your participation in the 2020 Census is safe and important to our community's future.
