Vehicles have the right away in Houston, on streets and highways. It is illegal in Houston to walk in the street if a sidewalk is available and accessible. Walking on the road is only lawful when something is blocking the sidewalk or

there is no sidewalk. If you must walk on the road or street, keep to the left, facing oncoming traffic. When there is oncoming traffic, move off to the left of the street or highway.


