



Novel Coronavirus is now known as COVID-19



How do people become infected with COVID-19?

Human coronaviruses most commonly spread from an infected person to others through:

- Respiratory droplets released into the air by coughing and sneezing;
- Close personal contact, such as touching or shaking hands;
- Touching an object or surface with the virus on it, then touching your mouth, nose, or eyes before washing your hands; and
- Rarely, fecal contamination.

What are the symptoms? Patients with confirmed COVID-19 infection have reportedly had mild to severe respiratory illness with

symptoms of:

- Cough
- Shortness of breath
 At this time, CDC believes
 that symptoms of COVID-19

may appear in as few as 2 days or as long as 14 days after exposure.

How can I avoid infection with COVID-19?

The best way to prevent infection is to take precautions to avoid exposure to this virus, which are similar to the precautions you take to avoid the flu. CDC always recommends these everyday actions to help prevent the spread of respiratory viruses, including:

- Wash your hands often with soap and water for at least 20 seconds. If soap and water are not available, use an alcohol-based hand sanitizer.
- Avoid touching your eyes, nose, and mouth with unwashed hands.
- Avoid close contact with people who are sick.
- Stay home when you are sick.
- Cover your cough or sneeze with a tissue, then throw the tissue in the trash. Clean and disinfect frequently.

Animal Care Services Seeking Feedback on Changes to Pet Sale Laws

Animal Care Services has teamed up with SASPEAKUP to gauge public opinion on proposed revisions that could mean big changes for local pet sales law.

An initial public done in the survey of 2019 summer garnered more than 3,200 responses with an overwhelming majority of respondents indicating unregulated pet sales in San Antonio contribute to our local animal overpopulation issues.

In response to that feedback, Animal Care Services has drafted a number of proposals revisiting the ordinance to further ensure the health and safety of animals in the community.

Proposals include enhanced penalties for violators as well as additional pet sales restrictions. A survey, available in both English and Spanish, can be accessed by San Antonio residents in a number of ways:

The survey runs through March 23rd.

It's currently illegal to breed or sell dogs or cats, puppies or kittens without a permit from ACS.

In addition to mandating humane care requirements like proof of the pet's rabies vaccinations and microchips, sellers are also required to display their permit numbers anytime they offer the animals for sale.

CPS Energy Solar, Efficiency Programs Extended One Year

CPS Energy's solar programs and energy efficiency initiatives will continue for another year while officials ponder the utility's next energy-saving moves.

San Antonio City Council members voted unanimously to extend CPS Energy's <u>Save For Tomorrow Energy Plan</u> (STEP), a more than decade-old conservation program. The council's vote means the utility's home solar, weatherization programs, rebates for energy-efficient appliances, and other programs will continue until 2021, at an estimated cost of \$70 million.

While council members praised the programs and CPS Energy's efforts to tell its customers about them, many said they wanted more discussion over the next year about what such initiatives would look like over the next 10 years. Stay tuned.
