Approval before change

Planning to paint your house, replace your roof, windows, change landscaping, build something, etc?

An approved architectural request is required first – before work begins. As of Jan. 1, 2019, a fine up to \$250 can be assessed.

Trash cans

Black trash cans with regular waste are collected on Tuesdays; blue cans with recyclables on Fridays. Have a green can? It will be collected with blue during the pandemic. The City says cans can be out by 6 p.m. the night before or by 6 a.m. the day of pickup. Our rules and regs say cans should not be on the street for longer than 12 hours prior to and after trash has been collected. Aim for replacing cans by 6 p.m. on pickup day.
