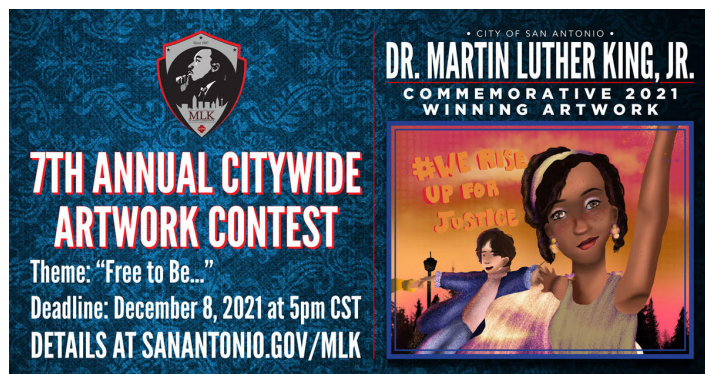

We are also working to secure additional silage tarps that black out plant life and allow everything to decompose to prep the area for spring.

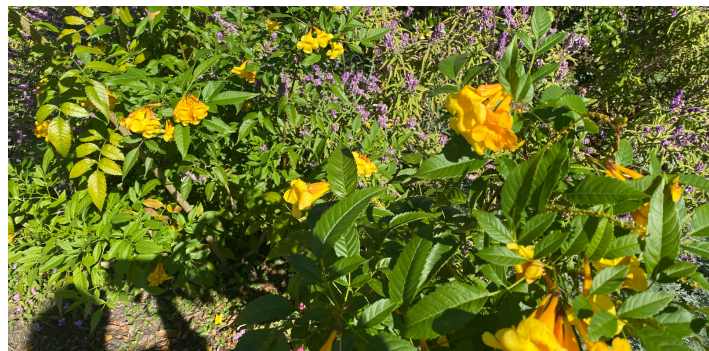

*"Lassos traditionally was so much more than a dance team. The Lasso experience fostered leadership skills, responsibility, teamwork and PRIDE in the school and in ourselves." - Marilyn Pfeiffer, class of 1972*

The Lassos are steeped in history and tradition. They were one of the first pep squads in America and possibly the only team performing rope tricks in their routines. Founded in 1933, the Lasso membership numbered 150 girls. Through the years, the ranks expanded to about 200.

The Lassos were known far and wide. In the 1930s and '40s, they were invited to appear at world fairs in Chicago and New York (they traveled by train!). On one return trip, they stopped in Washington D.C. and had tea with Mrs. Franklin Roosevelt.

The girls were expected to maintain high standards both academically and personally – grades and attendance were closely watched. They worked in their study hall periods as aides in the administrative offices, library, labs, classrooms and more. They served as runners during UIL contests held at the school. Lassos were invited to attend various City events – those red and blue uniforms, the hats and boots were unmistakable and considered a prime representation of San Antonio.

In the early 1970s, the dance component was added to the Lassos' performance skills. Within a few years, the Lassos had become more of a dance class with the marching and drill features taking a back seat. The traditional uniform was also allowed to fade. The group's practice location was moved from the main gym to rooms under the cafeteria wing, then squeezed into the old drama classroom off the auditorium. The group's numbers had also lessened.

In 2006 several Jefferson alumni came together after seeing only 5 girls marching in a Fiesta parade. Thus the Lasso Alumni Association was formed, bylaws written and tax status acquired. This group of concerned alumni coordinated with the school administration, describing the need to retain the tradition of Lassos and offering to help however they could.

Today, the Lassos are again well known within the Jefferson cluster in the SAISD and the girls are again held to high standards. They love it. Although the numbers are again low thanks to the pandemic, these students are passionate about keeping Lassos and their traditions and stories alive and well.
