

Metro Center Neighborhood Fight Back

Operation North 90

The purpose of this action plan update is to provide information to all stakeholders involved in the Metro Center Neighborhood Fight Back of the successes we are achieving in making Metro Center the safest mall within the metropolitan Phoenix area. During the problem identification process, businesses located on North Lane were identified as most problematic and a plan was constructed to deal specifically with them. These establishments are located within the designated fight back area and are considered "hot spots" due to high crime rates and calls for service. Based upon crime analysis, the targeted crimes were aggravated assaults (shootings and stabbings), sexual assaults, assaults, criminal damage, disorder crimes, and alcohol related crimes.

On **February 16 & 17, February 23 & 24, March 2 & 3, March 9 & 10 and March 16 & 17, 2007** (50 hours of enhanced enforcement), a collaborative effort was achieved by deploying Officers and Detectives from Cactus Park Precinct, Neighborhood Enforcement Team, Drug Enforcement Bureau, Gang Squad, and North Side Traffic Bureau to proactively engage in enhanced enforcement. They obtained the following exceptional results:
